


On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage








On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature






Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



**Threshold Voltage** 





Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient



Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient








Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient




Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case






# MICRO FOOT®: 6-Bump (1.5 mm x 1 mm, 0.5 mm Pitch, 0.250 mm Bump Height)




Mark on Backside of Die
